

Schuchard Elementary Bond Updates

SUMMER 2024

- Add corridor walls and doors in open-concept areas.
- Create additional layers of security to limit access for exterior corridor entry points, such as impact and shatter resistant glass.
- Replace door hardware and doors as needed for increased safety.

Thanks to the support of the UCS community, Schuchard Elementary will undergo a series of improvements funded by the 2023 safety and success bond issue.

One of the more significant projects will be the addition of doors and walls to areas of our building where classrooms are not currently closed. This was a significant safety need identified as a priority by the Schuchard community.

The bond funded projects will begin as soon as the 2023–24 school ends. The projects are expected to be completed by the time school begins this fall. Until that time, there will be restricted access to our building to allow crews to complete their work.
