Thanks to the support of the UCS community, Switzer Elementary will undergo a series of improvements funded by the 2023 Safety and Success bond issue.

Safety remains the priority for the bond projects, and part of our improvements will include the replacements of doors and door hardware as needed. This improvement also includes the installation of a heavy duty lockset that can be easily activated in emergency situations.

In addition, we are excited to introduce new playground equipment to ignite our children's imagination! The new equipment is focused on providing different ways to get our students moving and working together as they exercise to make physical activity fun!

The improvements will begin as soon as school is out for the summer. The work on the new playground is expected to continue into the fall. We will have at least one playground available to us when school begins in late August. The second set is planned for completion within the first few weeks of school.
