- One Chair pocket, labeled with name
- 1-1" Binder. Plain, solid color with clear outside pocket, labeled with name on the inside
- 1 small rectangular pencil box, labeled with name. Be sure it is plastic, we tape name plates on top when school starts. Please place these items inside:
 - 1 box 24 ct. crayons, labeled with name (we recommend placing crayons in a plastic reusable crayon container. Can be bought on amazon)
 - Several yellow #2 pencils, pre-sharpened, no design
 - Fiskars scissors, labeled with name
 - Glue sticks (4-6) labeled with name
 - 1 small pencil sharpener that fits in the pencil case
- Please make sure to have all items opened and ready to use inside their pencil cases!
- Be sure to pack an extra change of clothes in your child's backpack and them in there. Label everything!

First Grade
