Celebrate Cassie Hines





Cassie Hines was a 2009 graduate of Eisenhower High School and a proud member of the IKE volleyball program. As a junior, Cassie was diagnosed with a rare form of renal cancer. She was the middle child of three siblings—Ashley, Cassie, and Ethan—and remained surrounded by love and support throughout her journey.

Cassie attended Michigan State University and, in recognition of her perseverance and determination, was awarded a posthumous degree following her passing. Cassie passed away peacefully in 2012 at her home after several months in hospice care.

Cassie's legacy lives on through the Cassie Hines Shoes Cancer Foundation (CHSCF). The foundation was created to support young adults facing cancer by providing a safe space to connect, share their experiences, and support one another—while also offering opportunities to explore new places and enjoy meaningful experiences. Initially, CHSCF sent young adults to camps across the country. Today, the foundation proudly operates its own camp in Northern Michigan, hosting two to three camps each year.

This year, all funds raised will support camp enhancements, including inflatable kayaks, floating docks, and bike and boat rentals to enrich campers' experiences. The cost to send one camper to CHSCF Camp is approximately \$3,500. Last year, Eisenhower raised enough to send just over one camper. This year, our goal is to send at least two campers—continuing Cassie's legacy of hope, strength, and community.
