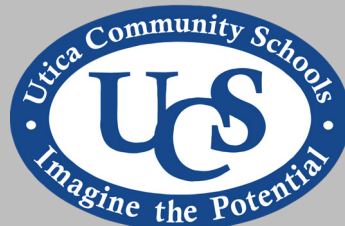

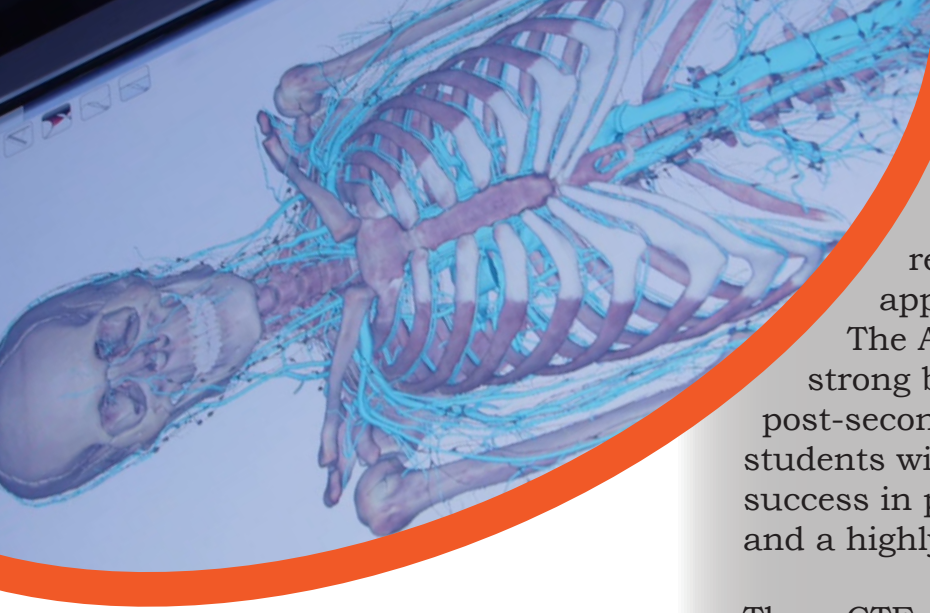

Utica HS Academy for Health and Human Services will offer a combination of rigorous academic content and relevant, real-world application of this knowledge. ## Why Should You Choose Utica High School Academy for Health and Human Services?

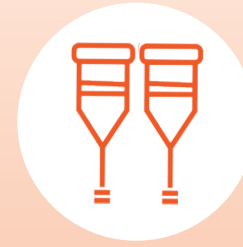
The Health and Human Services industry is one of the top growing job markets in the region and is projected to continue to grow.
