FUTURE PLANNING FOR GRAEBNER ELEMENTARY

COMPREHENSIVE FACILITY REVIEW

- A comprehensive review is ongoing for each elementary school. This review considers the age of the facilities, safety concerns based on the school's floor plan and overall student enrollment patterns.
- Facility improvements, renovations and/or a new addition/construction will occur
 at UCS elementary schools to provide our students and teachers the best possible
 learning environment that meets the high standards of our community.
- In partnership with our parents, the review will include input from a long-standing citizens committee (Enrollment Distribution Advisory Committee) that is comprised of representatives from each elementary school as well as input from school and district staff.
- This comprehensive, systematic plan will continue this spring with a final recommendation provided to the Board of Education in the fall by district leadership.

PHASE 1: Projects in this phase will be scheduled for summer 2024 through 2026

- Create additional layers of security to limit access for exterior entry points at main entrance and corridors, such as shatterresistant glass
- Replace drinking fountains with water bottle filling stations
- Install new playground equipment
- Replace playground surfacing

PHASES 2-5

- Upgrade network infrastructure
- Reconfigure classroom layout
- Upgrade security systems (cameras and access control)
- Improve exterior façade and landscaping
- Improve stage lighting and sound within the gym/cafeteria
- Renovate media center
- Renovate restrooms
- Upgrade plumbing and HVAC systems
- Upgrade power systems
- Upgrade interior and exterior lighting systems
- Purchase instructional technology equipment for classrooms
- Purchase computers for students and staff
- Purchase classroom furniture
- Purchase media center furniture
