

MacLean-Fogg Scholarship Program

Procedures & Guidelines

MacLean-Fogg will award the MacLean-Fogg Scholarship to one graduating senior from Stevenson High School.

Each MacLean-Fogg scholar will have been accepted by an accredited four-year college or university of their choice and have demonstrated academic excellence with particular emphasis in Mathematics, Sciences, Industrial Arts, and Engineering.

In addition, this individual must have demonstrated achievement, creativity, leadership and the "entrepreneurial spirit" in activities at school, in their community and in other areas of their life.

Academic excellence is an important criterion in the scholarship program, but the program is not based solely on the academic record of the applicant. The record of achievement, quality of leadership and "entrepreneurial spirit" that we attempt to reward in the MacLean-Fogg Scholarship program results in a broad selection criterion. However, preference will be given to applicants pursuing degrees in mathematics, sciences, industrial arts, and engineering.

Selection Criteria

ALL GRADUATING SENIORS from the above high schools are eligible to apply for the MacLean-Fogg Scholarship. Stevenson High School will forward all applications and recommendations to Stephanie D'Amico, HR Manager via email at sdamico@macleanfogg.com.

- 1- The application deadline will be Monday, April 1, 2024.**
- 2- Please return only pages 3 - 6 of this application packet, plus appropriate attachments. If necessary, copy a page and type or print your answer on the page provided.**
- 3- The MacLean-Fogg Scholarship Committee will review all applications, choose the top three candidates from Stevenson High School, and invite those finalists for an interview. One student will be selected to receive the MacLean-Fogg Scholarship.
- 4- The counseling office at Stevenson High School will be notified of the scholarship winner at their high school on or before May 8th, 2024.
- 5- The recipients will receive a plaque with their name inscribed on it.

Scholarship Requirements

- 1- The scholarship is \$3,000.00 for each of the four years of undergraduate study, to a maximum amount of \$12,000.

- 2- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to College/University Financial Aid Offices. There are no restrictions regarding the distribution or use of these funds. They may be used for tuition, housing or personal expenses and may be disbursed in a lump sum or in partial payments.
- 3- MacLean-Fogg scholars must be enrolled full-time and maintain full-time enrollment.
- 4- MacLean-Fogg scholars must maintain a "B" grade point average. That is, 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or 4.0 on a 5.0 scale. (This is not a cumulative grade point average.)
- 5- MacLean-Fogg cannot guarantee employment but will make every effort to provide MacLean-Fogg scholars employment during summer vacations and holiday breaks. The Company will also do its best to accommodate the scholar's wishes when making work assignments. Scholars are required to notify the Human Resources Manager, no later than 30 days prior to the work period requested.
- 6- MacLean-Fogg scholars are not required to accept employment as a condition of the MacLean-Fogg scholarship.
- 7- MacLean-Fogg scholars may be allowed under certain circumstances to take a leave of absence from full-time study for a semester or a full year without losing their scholarship eligibility. To ensure continuation in the scholarship program scholars must submit their leave of absence application in writing to the Human Resources Manager.

1. Information must be submitted in a typewritten format (**1 page per answer**).
2. You must obtain one recommendation from your high school and one personal recommendation from an outside reference (a person not related to you).
3. You must obtain a transcript of your high school grades and attach it to your scholarship application.
4. Attach a copy of your college acceptance letter to your application.
5. Attach a copy of your community service log to your application if you have one.
6. Please return your completed application (pages 3 - 6 of this application packet plus attachments) to your counselor by the scholarship deadline date.
7. Finalists will be invited to participate in an interview with the MacLean-Fogg Scholarship Committee.
8. The MacLean-Fogg Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship winner based upon your completed application and personal interview.
9. You will be notified of the scholarship winner.

Essay Prompts (2 of 4)

Reminder: To qualify, you must answer **ALL** essay prompts, 1 page per answer and information must be submitted in a typewritten form.

- 1- What is your academic objective in attending college? (please include your intended major and your philosophical objectives)
- 2- List 3 areas of personal achievement within the last year.
- 3- Define entrepreneurial spirit and how you exemplify this spirit. (what you believe an entrepreneur is and examples of entrepreneurial things you have done)
- 4- What academic experience during your junior and senior years was the most stimulating and why?
