- ▶▶▶ Student Council, Key Club and school store purchasing Bubble hockey and chess tables for the lunchroom

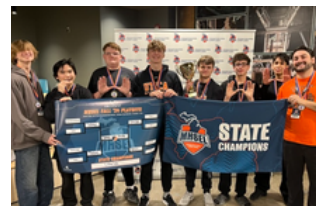
What Makes a Chieftain?
