SENIOR MEETINGS

All seniors and a parent or guardian **MUST** attend one of the senior parent meetings on Tuesday, April 16 at either 4:00 pm or 6:00 pm in the HFII PAC. FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Many seniors owe HFII a financial obligation for lost/damaged materials or technology. Seniors will not receive their cap and gown, nor will they be able to participate in senior activities (including graduation and prom) until these obligations are paid or items returned.

Most seniors have been notified if they have an obligation. You can look on PowerSchool to see if your student has an unpaid fine. If you see the green wallet (see below), your student has a fine. Contact Mrs. Bullock in the main office to take care of financial obligations.

CAPS AND GOWNS

Cap and gowns were ordered in October. Seniors who still need to order should see the Cap & Gown folder on the Class of 2024 Schoology page. Jostens is the exclusive provider of graduation products for UCS. Orders must be placed through Jostens. HFII cannot collect these orders. All caps and gowns will be delivered to HFII and distributed to seniors at the mandatory parent/senior meetings. Seniors with questions should see Mrs. Versele in room 125 or in the AO during lunch.

GRADUATION & GRADUATION TICKETS

Graduation is 10:00 am on Saturday, June 8, at the Oakland University O'Rena. Doors will open approximately one hour prior to the ceremony starting. At this time, we do not know the number of tickets that will be available for each graduate. This information will be shared when it is available. As in past years, a lottery will be held if there are extra tickets. Every effort is made to maximize the number of tickets each graduate will receive.

SENIOR PROM

Senior prom is on Wednesday, May 29 at the Palazzo Grande from 6:30 pm-11:00 pm. Students must arrive by 7:15 pm and are not permitted to leave until 10:00 pm. Information about prom will be discussed at the senior parent meetings. Ticket forms, rules, and additional information will be available on Schoology later in the spring.

DECISION DAY

This is a NEW event for our seniors this year! On May 1st, seniors should come to school wearing clothing that reflects their post-high school plans (college choice, career, military, trade, etc.). More details will be shared with our seniors in the spring.

I HAVE QUESTIONS, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

There is a lot of information that will be shared in the coming months. We will do our best to get you information as soon as we have it. **Seniors need to be checking their school email, Schoology alerts, and Teams messages! Notifications should be turned on for all of these so seniors do not miss important information and deadlines!** *There has been a lot of misinformation on social media the past few years-* please read the information we send home or have your senior check with Mrs. Versele (HFII teacher and senior class adviser) during the school day to get answers to questions.

SENIOR CLASS SHIRTS

About 60 students have not picked up the senior class shirts that they purchased in August. They have been available since October. If your student ordered a senior class shirt (*not class color shirt*) but hasn't picked it up they should go to the Activities Office at lunch to get it. If they do not have a lunch they should see Mrs. Versele in room 125.
