AP Exam Updates

As an UCMST student, your son or daughter will be enrolled in a variety of advanced placement (AP) classes over the years. These are college level classes that culminate with an **(optional)** comprehensive test that could earn your student college credit depending on their score. These tests for college credit are given in May and your child will sit for them at their home school. We do not administer AP tests at our building.

If your son or daughter is planning to take an AP exam this school year, they must register for the test now. Your child's teacher will provide them an **"EXAM ONLY"** code unique to their home school. Your student will enter this code into their Collegeboard account. If you would like to verify whether your student has successfully registered for their AP exam, please have them log into their Collegeboard account, and the screen will state they are registered to take the exam at ______ School.

Once your son or daughter registers to take an AP exam(s), you will receive an invoice from a 3rd party billing company in October. The cost is \$105 per exam (\$155 for AP Capstone Exams). The company must receive a \$40 deposit by October 31st, 2024. The remaining balance is due in February.

9th: AP Computer Science Principles

11th: AP Chemistry & AP Statistics

12th: AP Biology, AP Calculus BC, AP Chemistry, and AP Physics C
