Rationale for Pathways:						
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Michigan Merit Curriculum and the Utica Community Schools requires that students take and pass two years of a World Language. 2. 8th grade students may pursue Level 1 World Language courses for high school credit. To receive credit, they must earn a 70% or more as their final grade for each semester. 3. To optimize student success, Utica Community Schools requires sequential years of the same World Language. 						
Exceptions:						
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students may take an Advanced Placement (AP) class prior to their senior year by doubling up or testing out of a level. 2. Students who would like to accelerate their pathway must test out of the level they wish to skip. See the Utica Community Schools website for district-approved guidelines and testing out dates. 3. The World Languages taught in each building will depend on enrollment and staffing.
