2024 SAT Preparation Workshop

What is SAT Preparation Workshop?

This asynchronous course will provide students with an opportunity to explore the tools available on the College Board Student Portal, the Bluebook digital testing app and the free digital SAT prep courses available through Khan Academy. Students will be able to work through the course at their own pace and schedule. In addition, students will have the opportunity to become familiar with the assessment changes and be able to experience example digital items and sample digital tests similar to what will be implemented in the spring of 2025.

- Students will have access to join online sessions with a mentor.
- Two teacher led sessions will be available to students to attend and review the English and math portion of the SAT.
