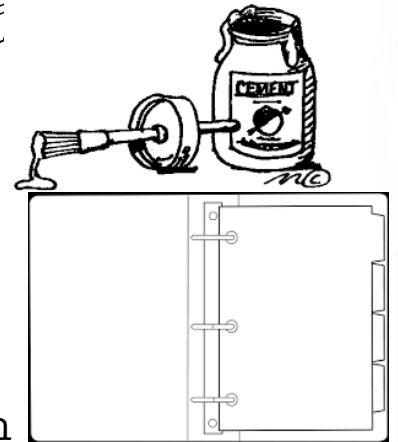
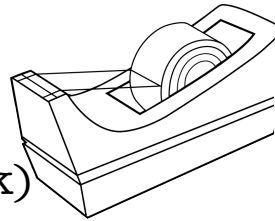


# 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Suggested Supply List



- 1- accordion folder
- 1- plastic durable folder
- 4 spirals- green, yellow, blue, and red
- Writing journal
- 1 graph paper spiral (must be wire bound or it will fall apart)
- 3 jars of rubber cement
- 4 red checking pens
- Sharpened Pencils
- Colored pencils (at least a 24 pack)
- Scissors
- 4 highlighters (different colors)
- Pad of Post-It notes
- Clipboard (recommended, but not necessary)
- Earbud headphones *with* case to keep them in
- 1 inch binder with poly-cover to slide a cover in  
(We will use this for our data binder)
- 5 tabbed dividers (To separate the sections of our data binder)
- Calculator (Recommended)
- 1-Clorox wipes
- 1- Kleenex box
- 1- Bottle of hand soap



\* We find that wire bound spiral notebooks work best and stand up to classroom use. Perforated paged and bound notebooks fall apart easily.

**We use scrapbook paper for our 6<sup>th</sup> grade memory books and other projects.**
