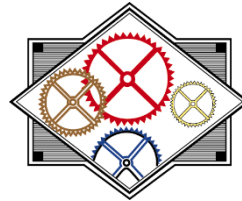

11, 12

1.0 credits

PREREQUISITE: School to Work Coordinator approval, and completed or co-enrolled in CTE Construction Trades

This employment experience is related to the career goals of the student and is supervised by a school-to-work coordinator. The student will develop workplace skills and leadership traits in their chosen area of specialty.
