

Playground Consent (One form per child)

The Michigan Department of Human Services, Office of Child Day Care Licensing, has established new criteria for playground and playground equipment. A public (school or park) playground is not required to meet all the same playground safety regulations licensed centers are required to meet. The playground equipment at the school may or may not have been inspected and meet with playground equipment guidelines. Given this information, in order for a child who is enrolled in a licensed program within a school approved by Michigan Department of Education to play on equipment, the parent must give their consent to play on the equipment with the understanding the equipment may not have been inspected or meet the current playground equipment safety requirements. If you choose not to give your child permission to play on the equipment, they will still be taken outdoors with the other children and will be offered an alternative activity.
