

Utica Community Schools 2024 Online Summer Bridge to Algebra I

What is Summer Bridge to Algebra I?

This course extends skills and concepts related to the critical areas of Math 7 and Math 8 to better prepare the student for Algebra I.

Who should enroll in this course?

- Advanced Math 100 students who received communication from their school stating the student **will** be enrolled in Algebra I in the Fall of 2024.
- Advanced Math 100 students who received communication from their school stating the student may be enrolled in Algebra I in the Fall of 2024.
 - Students who may enroll in Algebra I must attend an in-person orientation session and come in for all tests and the final exam.
- ☐ Advanced Math 7 students wanting to review content and prepare for Algebra I in the Fall of 2024.
- Math 7 students with a desire to advance in their mathematics pathway to Algebra I in the Fall of 2024.
 - Students who desire to enroll in Algebra I must attend an in-person orientation session and come in for all tests and the final exam.

How do I register?

Online registration will open on Monday, April 29, 2024, and will close on Friday, June 14, 2024.

When does the summer session begin?

Classes begin Monday, June 17, 2024, and end Friday, July 26, 2024.

No session on Thursday July 4, 2024, or Friday July 5, 2024.

How will my child receive the information to begin the online course?

Your student must attend an in-person orientation session the first week of the summer session (June 17, 2024 – June 21, 2024).

How often should my child work on this course?

The recommendation is at least 2 - 3 hours each day. This is a self-paced, computer-based course. While a mentor teacher is available for assistance, direct instruction is not available. This requires students to be on task and self-motivated.

Will my child need to attend additional in-person sessions?

Yes, only if your child received a letter from their school stating they **may** enroll in Algebra I (Algebra I in grade 7) in the Fall of 2024. If your child has the desire to move to the advanced math (Algebra I in grade 8) track in the Fall of 2024. In person sessions include orientation, tests and final exam.

Will transportation be provided?

Yes, a bus will be available at Eisenhower High School, Henry Ford II High School, Stevenson High School, and Utica High School. Students will need to be at their potential high school by 7:45 a.m. for transportation to Eppler Junior High School. Transportation will return students to their potential home high school between 12:00 p.m. – 12:30 p.m. for pick-up. Transportation to be indicated upon enrollment.

What time is the class?

8:15 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. Free breakfast is provided

8:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Summer Bridge to Algebra I

11:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Free lunch is provided

12:00 p.m. - 12:30 p.m. Transportation to high school hub for pick-up

Is there a cost for this program?

No, this program is supported by grant funds for the summer of 2024.

Will my child need their school computer?

Yes, your student will need to bring their school issued device and charging chord to each session. More information regarding devices will be provided in a follow up email in late May 2024.

Will my student receive a grade for this program?

Your student will not receive a letter grade for this course. Each student will be evaluated at the end of this course. Information from this evaluation will be shared with schools to finalize placement into Algebra I for the 2024-2025 school year.
