

# Yearbook 2023 Senior Portrait Info



## For pictures taken at *Prestige*:

- Seniors are encouraged to be photographed at *Prestige Portraits*, the district carrier, by **Saturday, December 17, 2022.**

- Seniors photographed by *Prestige* do **NOT** have to turn in photographs to be included in the Stevenson yearbook. *Prestige* will send a disk of all *Prestige* clients and automatically include the photo in the Class of 2023 composite (class picture for school hallway).

- A pose must be selected by **January 20, 2023** as the *Prestige* disk is scheduled for download **January 31, 2023.**



## For pictures not taken at *Prestige*:

- Students must **submit one picture** (CD, flash drive or hard copy) to the publication room (A-2) or Ms. Pantano's mailbox no later than **January 31, 2023. We do NOT accept emailed photos.** Digital photos should be sent via a CD or flash drive with student's name.

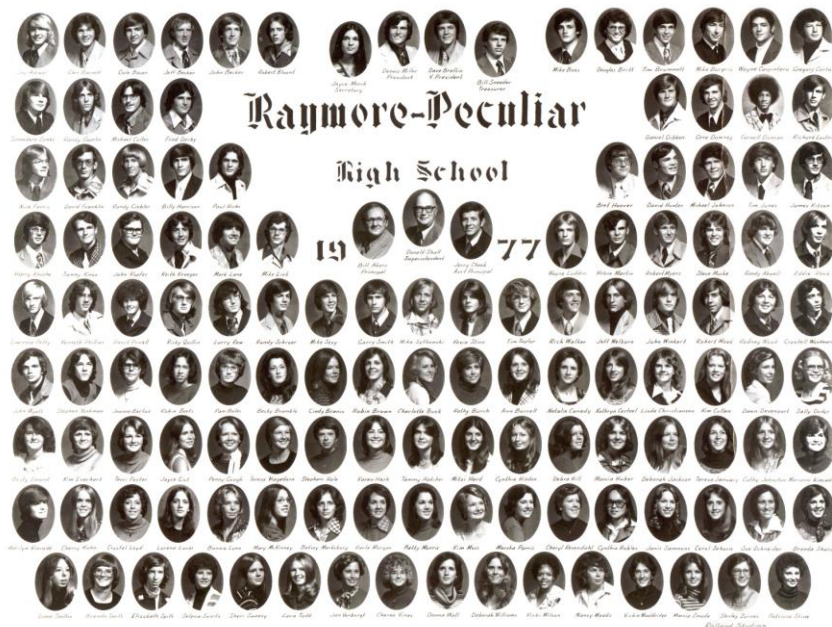
- Senior portraits not done at *Prestige* will have their school ID in the class composite. *Prestige* no longer accepts portraits from outside carriers.

Whether your senior picture is taken at *Prestige* or another studio, the yearbook staff should have your picture in their possession by **January 31, 2023** to avoid a possible \$25.00 late fee. **Do NOT email your photo.**

**Digital Specifications:** One inch from top of head to bottom of chin with blue-grey background. Submit image on CD, **clearly labeled with student's name.** Image must be in .jpg or .tif format. **Cannot be compressed. See spec sheet.**

# Class Composite Information:

- **YEARBOOK DOES NOT DO THE CLASS COMPOSITE.** The composite is created by *Prestige*, but under the supervision of the senior class advisor, Ms. Lisa Lucas (586-797-1956). Call Ms. Lucas with questions.
- Portraits taken at *Prestige Portraits* will automatically be included in the class composite. Photos must meet all specifications attached.
- Those with senior portraits NOT done at *Prestige* will have their senior ID picture used. *Prestige* no longer accepts outside photographer senior portraits for the composite.

# SPEC SHEET

**Take this sheet to your photographer** so he or she knows the requirements for your senior picture. **CD or HARD COPY ONLY - NO EMAIL**

## ➤ **Portrait Specifications:**

- Head Size from top of head to bottom of chin is one inch
- Print Size: 1-1/2 by 2 inches
- Natural blue-grey background only; plain; no other colors
- No double exposures, multiples, over-the-shoulder or group shots with animals or other objects
- Straight forward, no angled shoulders, must be looking at camera
- No cap and gown portraits, no hats, T-shirts, drapes, bare shoulders, hands, spaghetti straps, sleeveless or low-cut tops
- No backlighting
- There is a \$25 charge for resizing photos or photos handed in after deadline; late photos cannot be guaranteed for publication
- Whether your senior picture is taken at *Prestige* or another studio, the yearbook staff should have your picture in their possession by **January 31, 2023** to avoid a \$25 late fee. **Do NOT email your photo – it will NOT be accepted.**
